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WELCOME TO THE AMMERGAU ALPS NATURE PARK

The Ammergau Alps is Bavaria's largest nature park situated between the Zugspitze Mountain and Neuschwanstein Castle in the heart of the Bavarian Alps. Visitors find here a pure mountain landscape with cultural treasures.



Ettal with its world-known Benedictine Monastery, the over 400 years old brewery and distillery, is one of the major attractions. No more than 7.5 miles from Ettal, you can visit the fantastic gardens of Linderhof Palace, one of King Ludwig II dreamlike and unique castles. It is even said that this was the fairy-tale king's favourite castle, and it is the only one in which he still lived. Every year his birthday on August 25th will be celebrated with special guided tours and bonfires around Oberammergau on the night before.

Apropos Oberammergau: The Passion Play Village is not just popular for its beautiful "Lüftl" fresco paintings and

its world known wood carvers. Today the Passion Play Theater stages top class plays and operas every summer. Since 1928, the so called "Pest Spiel" illustrates how the Black Death came to Oberammergau. The Play tells the story of the day laborer Kaspar Schisler, who in 1632 amidst the turmoil of the Thirty Years' War worked as a servant for a farmer in Eschenlohe. The daily laborer missed his wife and children dearly and sneaked into the village during a church festival. Monday came and he was dead. At the month of October another 84 inhabitants perished. In this desolate situation, the people of Oberammergau made a vow to perform the story of the suffering and death of Jesus Christ every ten years so that God might end their suffering. It is told that since that day, not one inhabitant died from the plague anymore. In the year 1634 the people of Oberammergau then held the first-ever Passion Play. The drama will be staged in the Passion Play Theater.

For those who are looking for less culture and more silence, the surrounding villages have lots to offer: Unterammergau as a village marked by the fates of the whetstone makers, Saulgrub with its nature's beauty such as the Ammer Gap or Bad Bayersoien and Bad Kohlgrub,



the two spa resorts at the northern edge of the Ammergau Alps.

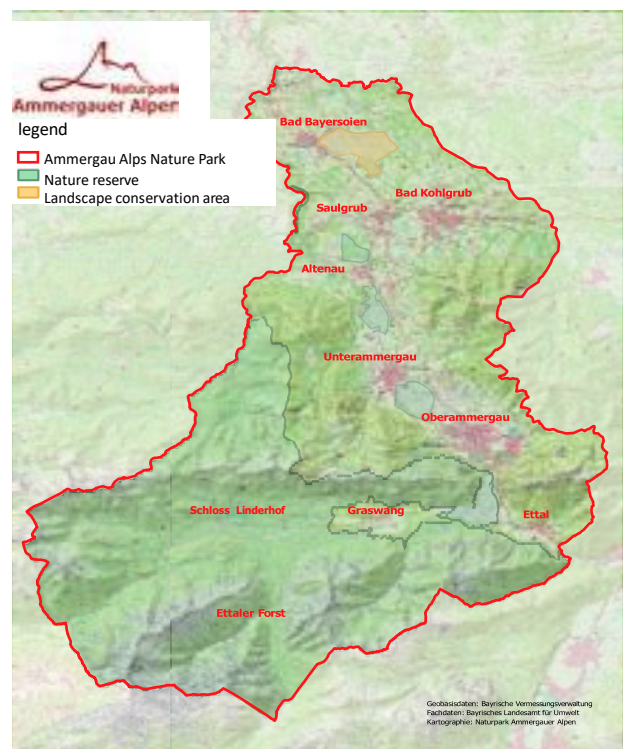

Our Nature Park

The “Ammergau Alps Nature Park” comprises 227 km². The region is 365 days in the year of “wood, meadow, river, mountains & moor”. From A as in Ammer Gap to Z as in Zeitberg at the foot of the Mount Hörnle. The Nature Park, where you can experience cultural and natural treasures, is situated 90 kilometers south of Munich and has already for decades focused on sustainability and environmental education. In summer 2017 it finally happened: the Ammergau Alps were declared the youngest Nature Park of Bavaria.

Promoting sustainable land use, value creation and regional development and strengthening regional identity, attachment to local roots and the quality of life.

Places in the Nature Park

The Ammergau Alps Nature Park comprises six Nature Park communities.

Bad Bayersoien

The health and Spa resort Bad Bayersoien is situated at the entrance of the Ammergau Alps Nature Park in the southern Pfaffenwinkel region. Romantic, colorful and full of the love of life, that is how

Bad Bayersoien presents itself to visitors as one of the recently classified moor spa centres in Bavaria. A beautiful countryside embedded in flower meadows and moors close to the lake Soier See. The village is a popular holiday destination for all kinds of people. It offers a variety of options such as: spa, wellness, active in the Nature and fitness.



Bad Kohlgrub

Bad Kohlgrub includes 13 small hamlets and three upper regions with their impressive farmhouses. There are views from Bad Kohlgrub which could not be more beautiful: a glance in one direction

shows the Alps in their full presence and in the other direction the rolling green mountain foothills with lakes and walking trails. Right in the village, the alpine peat “Bergkiefernhochnoor” is collected, a valuable natural healing substance which is applied, untreated, in the local moor spa centers.



Ettal/Graswang/Linderhof

Approaching Ettal from the south, the small commune is accessible by a winding mountain road. The village itself has few residents and all eyes are automatically drawn to the imposing monastery

building, even for travelers that are just passing through. It is the entrance to several cultural treasures and offers an extraordinary landscape beauty which can be discovered in the three town districts of Ettal, Graswang and Linderhof. Saulgrub/Altenau/Wurmansau

The commune of Saulgrub with its two village districts Altenau and Wurmansau is embedded in the protected nature reserve of the Ammergau Alps. As a gateway to the Alps, even long ago since Roman times, Saulgrub is located on an ancient Roman trading route. Today, in these friendly villages, the typical Bavarian vitality and rural cordiality, for which the locals are famous, can be still experienced. Due to the geographical situation, guests have the choice between hilly or smooth tours by foot, bike or cross-country skiing.



Oberammergau

A traditional wood carving village bursting with art and culture and enhanced by people with passion—that's Oberammergau. Besides the ancient tradition of wood carving that is also taught in the Oberammergau wood carving school and the world famous Passion Play, the village is additionally popular for its „Lüftmalereien“. Framed by the two landmark mountains Kofel and Laber, Oberammergau offers great hiking tours and offers also a cable car and a chairlift for a dreamlike bird's eye view of the valley.



Unterammergau

Artistically frescopainted farmhouses set the local scene of Unterammergau and contribute to the atmosphere of the village. Thanks to many apartments and countless activities in nature, the village is particularly suitable for family vacations. For centuries, Unterammergau has been characterized by the handicraft of whetstone making. Guests and little scientists can discover about the whetstone maker history and also search for some whetstones.

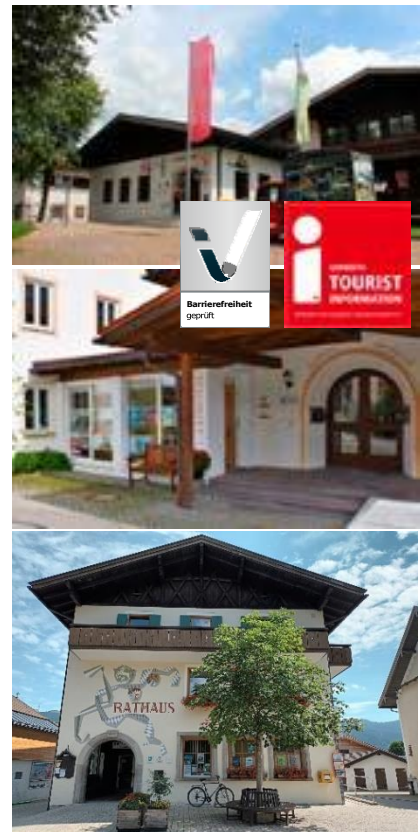

Wiesmahdweg Oberammergau/Bad Kohlgrub

Distance: 13.1 km Duration: approx. 4 hrs

Start: At Wellenberg(Oberammergau) Finish: Bad Kohlgrub

The Wiesmahd trail leads above Oberammergau to Kohlgrub. Return by bus. Strollers can be used only to Unterammergau.



Alpine Coaster Oberammergau

Distance: 5.2 km Duration: approx. 2.5 - 3 hrs

Start/Finish: Parking of the Coaster-chairlift

At the top, the restaurant Kolbensattelhütte invites you to rest and have a bite to eat and an adventure playground to romp around. The return is either by foot, with the chairlift or with the Alpine Coaster.



Ammer Gap Scheibum Saulgrub

Distance: 2.4 km Duration: approx. 1 hr

Start/Finish: Acheleschwaig (Saulgrub)

From the Achele near Saulgrub the trail leads to the 600 m long Ammer Gap through the rocks which has been a conservation area since 1949. In summer, the cold waters offer a welcome cooling off.



Long trail around the lake Bad Bayersoien

Distance: 3.8 km Duration: approx. 1 hr Start/Finish:
Rott Memorial in the town center of Bad Bayersoien,
past the Sun Dial Park in the direction of the spa area to
the lake Soier See.



During the walk you can stop at the Fischerhäusl for a bite to eat and a little rest. The long lake tour has the "Travel for All" certificate: Accessibility tested award.

Themed trails & educational trails

Educational **bird trail** Bad Bayersoien

Distance: 2.4 km Duration: approx. 45 minutes

Start/Finish: Lake Soier See, Parking at the Pano-
ramaweg (northern seaside)



At six stations you learn everything about the bird world at the lake Soier See. In the Tourist Information Center and the Fischerhäusl Bad Bayersoien you can borrow a TING-pen free of charge (20.00 € deposit). With its help the birds will sing at various stations.

Barefoot course at the lake Soier See Bad Bayersoien

Distance: 1.8 km Duration: approx.

30 minutes Start/Finish: Parking Fischerhäusl

The barefoot course leads once around lake Soier

See. At various stations, you can barefooted

feel pebbles, fine sand, hard edged bark mulch or cool wetness.



Timberland trail Bad Kohlgrub

Distance: 2.8 km Duration: approx. 1 hr

Start/Finish: Parking Hörnle valley station

The trail leads through the Ludwig Gorge in Bad Kohlgrub. On your way, you will discover rare ferns,

mosses and different tree types. Several play and rest stations help to experience the wood. The trail is complemented by the Locandy-App for an interactive wood experience. (Tip: Start In thr spa park and use the app to let the kids collect points in the quiz along the way.)



Educational moor trail Bad Kohlgrub

Distance: 1.5 km Duration: approx. 30 minutes

Start/Finish: St. Rochus Chapel, Parking civic amenity site

The information board explains how the peat has developed and what can be made from it. You can also see the excavator with which it is still extracted today.



Educational moor trail Bad Bayersoien

Distance: 1.1 km Duration: approx. 30 minutes

Start/Finish: Parking- Kirmesauer Straße

At several stations you learn everything about the origin and importance of the moor.



Bee path Bad Kohlgrub

Distance: 5.17 km Duration: 1.5 hours Start/End: Bad Kohlgrub spa gardens

Nine stations encourage participation and provide educational information

about the life of bees. The “Child Bee” gives the youngest child tasks to research and discover, and the “Gardener Bee” gives tips for a bee-friendly garden and the “scientist bee” provides information about life and actions of the small insect.



Adventure trail Bergwald Ettal

Distance: 3.2 km Duration: approx. 1 hr Start/Finish:

Parking at the cemetery in Ettal. Themes as for instance forest and water, animals of the forest, encounter with a tree,” Who am I

tree identification” are waiting at 12 stations to be discovered by you.



Grotto trail, the puzzle trail Oberammergau

Distance: 1.9 km Duration: approx. 1 hr Start/Finish:

hikers' car park on the Kofelauweg from the Döttenbichl in the direction of the new cemetery, the grotto trail leads along the Kofel to a shell-shaped cave with several rock carvings.



Grinding Mill Gorge Unterammergau

Distance: 1.5 km Duration: approx. 1 hr Start/Finish:

Parking place at Pürschling Unterammergau. A short hike through the Grinding Mill Gorge with many info's about the tradition-steeped whetstone production in Unterammergau.



Action packed leisure facilities in the Nature Park

Alpine Coaster Oberammergau

The world's longest, all-weather toboggan run with a modern magnetic brake system. At a maximum speed of 40 km/h, you will cover 73 curves and an altitude drop of 400 metres back into the

village. Children from the age of 8 are allowed to use the toboggan on their own.

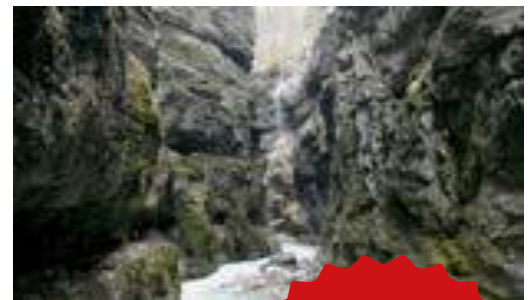

NATURAL ATTRACTIONS

Ammer Gap Scheibum Saulgrub

Over thousands of years, the Ammer near Saulgrub has cut an impressive gap into the rocks and has already been a designated conservation area since 1953. The Scheibum forms part of the Ammergau Alps meditation path and is seen as a place offering tranquility and energy.



Ammer Springs Oberammergau/Ettal

The Ammer springs are in the nature conservation area of the Ettal Weidmoos between Oberammergau and Ettal. Here you will find mainly water of the Linder, which continue further to the West in the Graswang village drains away, resurfacing in the form of multiple, inverted-pot-shape springs (Topfquellen). One of the pot-springs is easily accessible via the visitor platform so that you can observe the rising air bubbles. This pot-spring is located on the meditation path in the Weidmoos.



Lake "Soier See" Bad Bayersoien

The little Lake in Bad Bayersoien very quickly warms up and is not overcrowded even in the height of summer. In addition, the moor water is good for the body. The lake contains healthy humic substances which are formed in the surrounding moor.



Grinding Mill Gorge Unterammergau

Through the gorge above Unterammergau flows the Schleifmühlenlaine which is fed by the brooks from Pürschling, Teufelstättkopf and Schartenköpfel. In the 500 m long gorge the brook forms several pools and waterfalls which can be reached via a secured footpath.



Explanation of the trail sign

The signs in the entire hiking region were carried out according to the specifications of the German and Austrian Alpine Association (DAV/ÖAV). In the following examples the structure of a signpost is explained:

- Valley routes - Wide, easy to walk trails close to the valley without fall hazard (the risk of falling from a height).
- Simple mountain trails - predominantly narrow, can be steep and do not include any passages with fall hazard.
- Mountain trails of medium difficulty - predominantly narrow, often steep and can include passages with fall hazard. They may also have in addition short, secure passages.
- Difficult mountain trails - narrow, often steep and include fall hazard. In addition, they have an increased number of secured hiking passages and/or simple climbing sections which require the use of hands. Surefootedness and a head for heights are necessary!

AMMERGAU ALPS ACTIVITY HOLIDAYS

Eco-friendly out and about in summer

The attraction of mountain sports is to a large extent determined by the experience of Nature. Hikers, mountaineers and cyclists are therefore mostly out and about in particularly precious natural environments and sensitive ecosystems. By following the tips below you respect the nature and environment of the largest continuous nature conservation area of Bavaria, the Ammergau Alps, when hiking and mountaineering.



Free access right – As a general rule, an access right to the open countryside applies in the Alps: “For the purpose of recreation, access to the open fields are at one’s own risk allowed”.

Restricted access right in protected areas – The access right can be restricted in protected areas (nature conservation areas of the Ammergau Alps) with a “Wegegebot” which restricts access to certain paths or roads. In conservation areas, you should therefore keep to the marked routes.

Outside of conservation areas you should also **stay on the paths and roads**. Off paths and roads, hikers cause considerable unrest amongst wild animals.

Use marked routes – especially in wood and moor areas. This is more comfortable and in line with a well-thought-out guidance through ecologically sensitive areas.

Avoid shortcuts – Depending on the geological subsoil and slope gradient, little shortcuts at road bends can develop an erosion gully and eventually a large

area of land degradation. This can locally lead to the endangering of hiking trails or even to their destruction.

Take your litter home – Not leaving any litter behind should be a matter of course. Please also take any compostable food remains back into the village, as the biological decomposition advances much more slowly under mountain conditions!

Spare plants – Rather take photos of plants instead of picking them. This is a contribution to the protection of species, and the next walker can also enjoy their splendor.

Show consideration for each other – When you are out and about with your bicycle, remember that pedestrians have always the right to pass first. Avoid narrow paths at “peak times” such as bank holidays and weekends.

Watch out when crossing alpine meadows – Your crossing of alpine meadows can worry cattle. You should take particular care where mothers are raising their young! Animals can react aggressively to a dog.

Close pasture gates – after crossing a mountain pasture please close the gate again. An open pasture gate can put the grazing animals in serious danger.

Do not enter meadows and fields – after crossing a mountain pasture please close the pasture gate again. An open pasture gate can put the grazing animals in serious danger.

Recommended hiking tours

Ammergau Wiesmahd Trail Oberammergau/Bad Kohlgrub

A part of the hiking trail is also known as Altherrenweg and is situated on the sunny side of the Ammertal. It allows a continuous walk between Bad Kohlgrub and Oberammergau, through the meadows and pastures at the foot of Aufacker and

Through the Graswang Valley to the Palace

The start of the hike is at the Ettal Mill. The continuously flat hike leads you first through the idyllic Weidmoos, then past the Ammer springs and on to Graswang. Via a forest road you will reach the Linderhof Palace.

Climbing and nature conservation

With approximately 300 square kilometers, the Ammergebirge is the second largest nature conservation area in Germany. Many rare animals and plants find refuge here. The areas Zahn, Kofel, Frauenwasserl and Falkenwand are located within the nature conservation region, all the others are in proximity. To preserve this unique natural landscape, certain rules must be observed.



The basic prerequisites comprise here as elsewhere:

Everybody takes his litter back home, no closed roads are entered by car, noise level is categorically kept at a minimum, intelligent parking eco-friendly driving to a destination, respect breeding periods of birds.

If rock closures are ignored, as for instance at the “Nasser Ritz”, total closures will be inevitable in order to protect the wildlife. If you are looking for further tips or current info's in connection with this topic, go to www.dav-felsinfo.de An occasional word to the more heedless climbers amongst the climbing fraternity would therefore not come amiss, so that in future all can still have a great time on and in the rocks.



MY CULTURE TIME

The best-known sights in the Ammergau Alps Nature Park include:

Ettal monastery and its Basilica

As redemption of a vow because of his safe return to Bavaria, Emperor Ludwig the Bavarian found the Benedictine monastery, which still exists today. The religious vow foundation had practical purposes, such as securing transport routes, developing the area and establishing a foundation for knights and their wives. The church was completed in 1370 after 40 years of construction. After secularization in 1803, Ettal revived monastic life again in 1900. During a guided tour through the basilica or the brewery museum and the distillery, one can have a look inside the monastery.

Linderhof Palace

Linderhof Palace is the smallest of the three castles of King Ludwig II and the only one that was completed during his lifetime. It is considered the favorite castle of the „fairytale king“, where he stayed by far the most. The park combines motives from the French and the Italian Baroque gardens and the English landscape garden. The castle can be visited as part of a regular guided tour (English), and the park is free to the public.

Passion play Theater Oberammergau

In 1634 the vow was fulfilled on a simple wooden scaffold in the cemetery. In 1830 the stage moved to the place of today's Passion Play Theater. In 1890 a new stage was built there. In 1900 a covered auditorium and an open-air stage were built with an iron scaffold construction with six high arches, and in 1930 the stage was given its present form. The Passion Play Theater can be visited on guided tours.

HEALTH

Alpine peat “Bergkiefernhochmoor”

The alpine peat “Bergkiefernhochmoor” from the Nature Park region in the Ammergau Alps is a recognized natural remedy. It is cut and directly administered in the spa facilities of the mud spas Bad Bayersoien and Bad Kohlgrub. The thickflowing full mudbaths are something really special. As a health remedy the bath mud is administered in cases of rheumatism, gout and arthrosis etc. The constituents of the bath mud have a positive effect on the female hormone balance. The bath mud is therefore also employed to treat gynecological complaints (menopause) and in dealing with childlessness.



What you should also know

- For all those who would like to experience the effect of the natural remedy Bergkiefernhochmoor, “tasters” or mud packs are recommended.
- Mud applications are administered in the bath sections of the spa facilities in Bad Bayersoien and Bad Kohlgrub. Guests not staying in one of these establishments can also make an appointment there. Mud baths are offered on Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings.
- We can recommend the individual offers of these establishments as well as the “mud packs”. These arrangements combine mud applications and other services for a mud therapy lasting one, two or three weeks.
- Due to the intensive effect of the alpine Bergkiefernhochmoor baths, it is necessary to visit a spa doctor before the mud application.

TIP

In summer, the Ammergau Alps offer guided bike tours. The “moor tour” includes a guided tour through the Bad Kohlgruber moor nature trail. An expert will provide you with knowledge about the natural remedy mud and how it works. Book your ticket directly with us.

Corpus Christi Procession

The Corpus Christi Procession takes place on the Thursday after Trinity Sunday (on the 60th day after Easter Sunday). The Thursday as a fixed date is closely connected with Maundy Thursday and the associated introduction of the Eucharist by Jesus Christ.



Charcoal Burner Days Bad Kohlgrub

Here the visitors are given an unforgettable insight into the work of the charcoal burner and charcoal production. Between the ignition of the charcoal stack and the “harvest”, a comprehensive festive program with entertainment is offered (only in May).



St. Johns Day fire in Bad Bayersoien

Around June 24th, St. Johns Day, the St. Johns Day fire is traditionally lit at dusk in Bad Bayersoien. The Soier See offers the perfect backdrop for one atmospheric summer evening. The Bad Bayersoien brass band plays and the traditional Blaskapelle entertains with Plattler performances and the Goaßlschnalzern.



King Ludwig Bonfire Oberammergau

The King Ludwig Bonfire is a traditional bonfire display which takes place annually on the 24th August, the evening before the birthday of King Ludwig II.



King-Ludwig-Night Linderhof

On the 25th of August, the birthday of King Ludwig is commemorated in Linderhof Palace and in the park. In addition to special guided tours through the Linderhof Palace and gardens the event also includes musical performances in the honor of the King.



Leonhard Ride Unterammergau

The Leonhard Ride, a procession on horseback, takes place annually on the last weekend in October in Unterammergau in honour of the Holy Leonhard of Limoges.



Winter Balloon Days Bad Kohlgrub

Every year the Winter Balloon Days take place in Bad Kohlgrub: During the last week in December and the beginning of January - at the turn of the year - this is the only event of this type in the German alpine region.



Star walk Oberammergau/Ettal/Graswang

Every year on New Year's Eve locals and guests, accompanied by singers and musicians, walk through Oberammergau, Ettal and Graswang carrying a large, illuminated star. This custom differs from the "star singers" who in other locations, mostly on January, go singing from house to house.

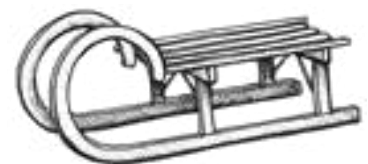

DAV Eco-friendly ski mountaineering

By observing the following tips, you show consideration for the nature and environment of the Ammergau Alps:

- **Observe** the regulations of **protected and closed areas** (see DAV maps), respect in particular animals and plants, and avoid noise.
- **Take account of signs, advice and route recommendations** of the DAV project “Eco-friendly Ski Mountaineering”.
- **Recognize habitats:** avoid as far as possible wild animals, only observe them from a distance, circumvent feeding stations, take dogs on a lead.
- In the depth of **winter avoid summits, mountain backs and ridges** before **10 am and after 4 pm**.
- In **forest** regions and at the forest border **stay on the usual ski routes**, forest and hiking trails. **Keep a distance** from groups of trees and bushes.
- **Treat with care reforestations and young forests.**
- **Make the journey to your destination eco-friendly:** travel with public transport or form carpools, use indicated car parks, block any access.
- **Choose a stay of several days** rather than planning frequent day tours, make **use of the local gastronomic offers.**
- Plan tours with guides and maps carrying the DAV-quality seal “Eco-friendly ski tours/winter tours” and find out about the nature and culture of your destination.
- Follow the rules for ski tours on ski pistes.

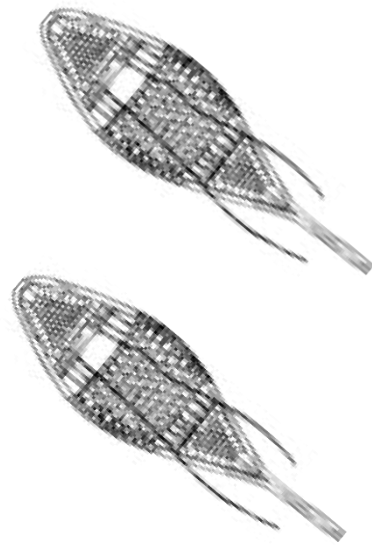
